




This is the hallway.




This is my classroom.




This is where I work.



I work very hard at school.




I like at working on my iPad at school.

Sometimes a door is closed...






... and I want to open the door.

If the door is closed, it means students are working hard and they would like it quiet.







Sometimes a door is open...






... and I want to close the door.

But if I close the door it will be very loud.






I don't want to bother the students.



Teachers and students will be VERY proud if I leave their door alone.






Because they are working VERY hard like me.
